

Court Case against the IEC delivered to Supreme Court - Bloemfontein



Dear Supporter,

Our lawyers have put together a comprehensive case against the IEC's exclusion of the Cape Independence Party on the Western Cape ballot.

After submitting our complete candidate list, paying the required deposit, and delivering a total of 11,114 voter signatures from across the country, of which approximately 7,500 supporter signatures are registered voters in the Western Cape, well in excess of the requirements set for parties under the new regulations, our case will now be heard in the Electoral Court in the Supreme Court of Appeals in Bloemfontein.

Following issues experienced with the IEC's online platform on Friday 8 March, the only option available for submissions was to submit our comprehensive documents to the IEC via email. The IEC is claiming that they refuse to accept receipt of such documents via email.

This is ironic considering that all legal correspondence with the IEC in this court matter, with document sizes well in excess of what the IEC online platform is capable of receiving, have been perfectly well accepted by them and their legal team.

We look forward to the Supreme Court hearing next week Monday, and we thank everyone for their messages of support as once again we battle the IEC for the simplest of democratic rights to be fairly represented, and for voters to vote in free and fair elections for a political ideology of their choice.
