Dear Supporter,

We are disappointed to announce that we have lost our court case against the IEC to an outrageous ruling.

We have close relationships with the civic organisation, but particularly the exceptional and selfless Dr Michael Louis, who covered the massive costs, and who launched the Constitutional Court challenge against the new regulations which created the never before enforced and undemocratic regulations intended to prevent parties from contesting the elections.

These new regulations have de facto prevented voters from expressing their free and fair democratic right to vote for a political ideology of their choice in a supposed democratic electoral system.

Not only was Dr Michael Louis' Constitutional Court challenge unsuccessful in putting an end to the new regulations passed by the ANC government, but so too was our recent court case challenge against the IEC and their intention to exclude us from the Western Cape Provincial elections.

In spite of us submitting a total of 11,114 signatures to the IEC, of which over 7,500 were registered voters in the Western Cape, the Electoral Court still ruled against us. We were unable to upload the huge files to the IEC via their dysfunctional IEC portal, and as a result were forced to submit our signature files via email.

Even though we submitted well in excess of the required number of signatures to contest the elections, the IEC argued that we had not done so on technical grounds.

The court ruled that the only acceptable method in which to submit such files was via the IEC online platform, or physically in person at the Gauteng IEC offices. Of which, both options were impossibilities for us, and so we were forced to submit via the only channel available to us at the time, via email.

Even though we are bitterly disappointed with this outcome, we would also like to give a huge thank you to everyone who fought so hard against this IEC injustice and the various other battles we have fought over the last few months. We want to give a massive and special thank you to our legal team and all of our members and supporters for their love, dedication and support.

We would also like to individually applaud Dr Michael Louis for his noble efforts with regards to the Constitutional Court challenge.

Nonetheless, in spite of all of this we are now smarter than ever to the extent of the hurdles and tricks that the South African government system will go to in its attempts to silence the voice of voters who oppose them.

We have multiple court cases and various Cape focused projects underway that are fighting to bring more decentralisation to the current political system, and justice for the Cape people, and this recent set back does absolutely nothing to deter or alter our unflinching focus on the pathway ahead.

We look forward to smashing these boundaries in the 2026 elections, and continuing full steam ahead with the above projects, and more, as we guarantee to be the most principled and unbending political vehicle to bring freedom in the truest sense, and prosperity, to our beloved home, the Cape of Good Hope.
