



The Cape Independence Party - CAPEXIT Participates at the Global Summit on Self-determination



Dear Supporter,

On 22 February 2025, the second Annual Global Summit on Self-Determination convened in-person and virtually, brought together representatives from across the world, including independence movements from within the United States and from across multiple continents, as well as two renowned scholars specialising in the formation of new nations. Hosted by the California Independence Movement, Calexit LLC, this summit marked a significant step toward strengthening the United Self-Determined Nations - a global coalition where leaders of independence movements present their cases, foster mutual collaboration, and enhance the unity and influence of this growing cause.

Among the key issues raised was the case for Western Cape independence, passionately articulated by Jack Miller, Leader of the Cape Independence Party (CAPEXIT) and visionary founder of the Cape independence movement - for a peaceful and prosperous independent state. Miller emphasised that in the 30 years since the African National Congress came to power, the Western Cape has consistently rejected the ruling party at the polls. He further noted that the region

loses 75% of its tax revenue to the national government each year, underscoring a lack of fiscal autonomy.

Miller also drew attention to detrimental government policies disproportionately affecting Western Cape residents, alongside pressing concerns such as the ongoing torture and murder of white Afrikaans farmers - who endure a homicide rate four times higher than that of wartime Iraq. He highlighted inflammatory rhetoric from racist and fascist politicians, including public calls of "Kill the Boer!" which exacerbate tensions in the region and in the country at large.

The global trend of organisations seeking peaceful secession from overbearing central governments continues to gain momentum. In the Western Cape, independent polls indicate that 68% of residents support a referendum on independence. The Cape Independence Party remains committed to this cause, vowing to intensify pressure on the Democratic Alliance to devolve powers down and to ultimately secure a referendum through the electoral process.
