On 24 Dec 2023, 150 shacks in a community in Cape Town's Lavender Hill suburb called Hillview, were engulfed by flames and destroyed, leaving 400 to 500 people destitute.

Some assistance has already been provided, but many people are still without food, water, furniture, clothing, school uniforms and school stationery.

As can be seen in the below video, the Cape Independence Party's Councillor Karl Bodin appeals to Cape Town residents to find it in their hearts to contribute in any way possible. Non-perishable food, clothing, furniture, school uniforms and stationery are the most urgent needs.
