

South African Government Human Rights Violation



Dear Supporter,

The United States' President Donald Trump has announced that all funding to South Africa will be ceased until a full United States investigation into South Africa's controversial Expropriation Without Compensation bill, recently signed into law, has been done.

This new law empowers state authorities to seize land and property from individuals and businesses without paying for it. Trump called it a "massive human rights violation, at a minimum", saying it is happening for all to see" and added that "The United States won't stand for it" as is evident from social media platforms such as X (previously 'Twitter') as well as through mainstream media outlets.

This law will inevitably lead to increased uncertainty among investors, exacerbate existing economic challenges, and inflame social tensions. In Ramaphosa's recent SONA 2025 address he showed no intention to change the South African government's racist policies of BEE, EWC, Employment Equity Act, BELA ... etc.

The Cape Independence Party - CAPEXIT is in full agreement that the guarantee of South African citizens' property rights under Section 25 of the Constitution should not be negotiable or open for debate, and welcomes the international community taking a serious view of this injustice.

In its ongoing quest for an independent Cape, the Cape Independence Party continues to position itself against the erosion of basic human rights through politically motivated policies such as Expropriation of property Without Compensation and remains steadfast in our belief that the people of the Cape deserve to govern themselves and to do so without fear of confiscation of their property.

We will continue to push for legislation that upholds all individual liberties, and to move the current centralised system towards a more decentralised form of governance.
