Councillor Karl Bodin of the Cape Independence Party - CAPEXIT recently exposed a massive raw sewerage outflow onto Strandfontein Beach, Mitchells Plein and into our public False Bay waters.

Cllr. Bodin has been invited to occupy the one and only Opposition Seat in the City of Cape Town's Executive Mayor's Advisory Committee for "Water Quality in Wetlands, Waterways, and Coastal Environment."

Through his presence on the Mayor's Advisory Committee, Cllr Bodin seeks to hold the City and the DA accountable for their deeply concerning policies and inaction with regards to this matter of environmental and public health. In addition, he has been invited to participate in the public pressure and advocacy group "Bays of Sewage" which will give him further insight into the extent of the water quality issues which have been uncovered.

“The continuous overflow of sewerage pollution onto the Strandfontein Beach is very disturbing to witness and the City has done nothing to address this escalating problem. Our recent laboratory results have proven that E-Coli levels are dangerously high and that immediate action needs to be taken. Cape Town has some of the most beautiful beaches in the world, and we will do whatever we need to do to ensure that the government keeps them safe and clean.” Cllr Bodin said.

The Cape Independence Party will continue to monitor this case and keep our supporters and Cape Town residents informed of any developments in this matter as we continue to hold the DA and the Cape Town City Council to account.
